1. Step #1: Open the doors, (v. 3).

- a. Everyone involved needs to know what is expected...

- b. Open confession of the sins which brought them to this point, (vs. 6-7)

3. Step #3: Get all involved in the work of restoration, (vs. 12-19)

4. Step #4: Restore the worship to God's specifications, (vs. 20-35)

a. Hezekiah brought into the restored temple the leaders of the people. (v. 20)

b. Hezekiah restored sacrifices, (vs. 21-24)

c. Not only the sacrifices but all acts of praise are restored as God has commanded, (vs. 25-28)
