Psalm 133:1-3

I. The Challenge of Youth – Part 2, (2 Chronicles 35)

A. A Passover Like None Other, (vs. 1-19) – Four Sections...

1. Proper Preparations for the Passover, (vs. 1-6)

a. (v. 1), *“Then Josiah celebrated the Passover to the Lord in Jerusalem....”*

Leviticus 23:5

Exodus 12:2, 6

1 Corinthians 11:17, 20; 16:2

Acts 20:7

Hebrews 3:13; 10:24

John 4:23; 17:17

2. Provision of the sacrificial animals, (vs. 7-10)

a. (v. 7), *“Josiah contributed to the lay people, to all who were present, flocks of lambs & kids....”*

1 Corinthians 5:7

b. Other leaders also gave, (vs. 8-9), *“His officers also contributed a freewill offering to the people....”*

Matthew 20:25-28

Romans 12:1

3. Service of the offerings, (vs. 11-15)

- a. The serving was a blessing that brought all the people together. (vs. 11, 13, 15)....

1 Corinthians 10:15-17

4. The fulfillment of Josiah's commands, (vs. 16-19)

- a. (v. 16), *"So all the service of the Lord was prepared ... according to the command of King Josiah."*

B. The End of King Josiah's Reign, (vs. 20-27)

1. The Battle of Carchemish, (vs. 20-24)

- a. (v. 20), *"After all this, when Josiah had set the temple in order, Neco king of Egypt came up...."*

- b. Pharaoh Neco did not want to fight Josiah, (v. 21)

- c. (v. 22), *"Josiah did not turn away from him, but disguised himself in order to make war with him...."*
