I. Apprentice Goal #3: “Doing as Our Rabbi Did” (Part 1)

A. Our Rabbi is *Always Teaching*

1. His 3-step plan teaching method is one that is used during a physician’s internship.
 - a. First; You do, and I watch you . . .

2. Even in His “*doing & teaching,*” Jesus was also giving us an example for how He too followed God’s will.
 - a. After healing a sick man, John writes, “*For this reason the Jews were persecuting Jesus....*”

2. To a group of Jews and their leaders, Jesus said, “*He who rejects Me and does not receive My sayings....*”

3. Peter now encourages us to follow this same teaching method.

a. This is literally praying with our body, i.e. offering all that we are in worship.

3. _____ :: As one writer said, “We generally sin *alone*, but we heal *together*.”
