2. (v. 2), "You yourselves know full well that the day of the Lord will come just like a thief in the night." a. Thieves do not advertise their coming. Nor does the Lord.

3. (v. 3), "While they are saying, 'Peace! Safety!' then destruction will come upon them suddenly...."

B. Sons of Light versus Sons of Darkness, (vs. 4-11)

- 1. (vs. 4-6), "But you, brethren, are not in darkness, that the day should overtake you like a thief....";
 - a. Paul continues to use physical terms to refer to spiritual realities

1 John 1:5-7

John 3:19-20 (9:5)

b. These Thessalonian Christians were walking in the light – "...not of night or darkness."

- 2. (vs. 7-10), "So then let us not sleep as others do, but let us be alert and sober...."
 - a. Jesus told a story using this same metaphor

b. 8"But since we are of the day, let us be sober, having put on the breastplate of faith and love...."
