# **ASSURANCE AT THE JUDGMENT**

## I. Judgment is Certain—But So is Assurance

**A.** The Day of Judgment is not a maybe—it's a *certainty!*

### II. Perfect Love Casts Out Fear

A. Those whose hearts are shaped by God's love & who live accordingly, need not fear God's judgement

## III. Jesus' Words & Example: Judgment with Confidence

**A.** Jesus prepared us for judgment, not to be afraid, but by giving our lives peace and purpose.

<b>B.</b> The early church <u>prayed boldly</u> because of their assurance in Christ.

IV. How to Prepare for the Judgment with Assurance
<ul><li>A. How-To's for Assurance:</li><li>1. Live transparently before God: (Psalm 139:23-24)</li></ul>
2. Abide in Christ daily – ( <b>John 15:5–6</b> )
3. Walk in the light – (1 John 1:5, 7)
4. Rest in grace, not in guilt – (Eph. 2:8–9)
5. Eagerly Anticipate His coming – (2 Tim. 4:7–8)
C. The judgment isn't a "finish line" where God wants to condemn unbelievers but 2 Timothy 2:5
V. Conclusion: Confidence – YES!!, Condemnation – NO!!
Guests: We can absolutely have confidence at the judgment, but only if we chose to follow God's plan
