A. Using Inferences to Interpret Another Bible Passage

1. When speaking to the religious rulers of His day, Jesus uses an inference to interpret **Ex. 3:6**.

B. Writers Often Use Inferences and Expect Us to Understand Them

1. Some inferences use a type of reasoning called, “from the lesser to the greater.”
